Vote-by-Mail Ballot

The Deadline for requesting a vote by mail ballot to be mailed for the current election is 5 pm, March 20, 2025.

Vote-by-Mail Ballots:

- May be dropped off at Early Voting Sites in operation prior to Election Day.
- **CAN NOT** be dropped off at polling locations on Election Day.
- Must reach the Supervisor of Elections, in DeLand, by 7 pm on Election Day in order to be counted.

Photo & Signature Identification

Prior to voting, voters shall be required to present a current and valid photo identification.
