Description:	Supervises assigned personnel which involves such duties as assisting with selecting and allocating employees, planning, reviewing and assigning work, training, maintaining standards, acting on employee problems, providing counseling/discipline, appraising performance, and recommending promotions, demotions and salary actions  Oversees operation and maintenance procedures on all lift stations, sewer lines, manholes, and any other wastewater collection related equipment
	Reviews, coordinates and implements new or revised local, state or federal laws and regulations pertaining to wastewater collections
	Inspects work performed by contractors to ensure compliance with City policies and standards
	Responsible for compliance with the City's safety program, pertaining to assigned departmental activities
	Supervises the daily operations of the Wastewater Collection activities and assigned vehicle maintenance
	Provides information and assistance to the general public as well as responds to complaints
	Works in conjunction with all City departments regarding various activities/functions
	Assists with preparation and administration of departmental budget
